1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for the Mississippi Riverfront
1.3 Trail; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. WINONA; MISSISSIPPI RIVERFRONT TRAIL.

1.6 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$5,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.7 to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to the city of Winona for development
1.8 of the Mississippi Riverfront Trail in accordance with the city's comprehensive plan. This
1.9 appropriation includes money to design, construct, and equip safe corridors for trail users
1.10 to avoid heavy truck traffic and other potentially hazardous areas.

1.11 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.12 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.13 the state in an amount up to \$5,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.14 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.15 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.16 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
