1.6	Section 1. NORTHLAND COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE
1.7	AVIATION MAINTENANCE TRAINING CENTER.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$3,732,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9	fund to the Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities for the
1.10	aviation maintenance training center on the Thief River Falls airport site of Northland
1.11	Community and Technical College. This appropriation is to demolish approximately
1.12	22,000 square feet of the existing structure, complete predesign, design, construct new and
1.13	renovate existing spaces, furnish, and equip the aviation maintenance training center with
