1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$1,434,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7	fund to the commissioner of administration for the purposes specified in this section:
1.8	(1) \$64,000 is to complete design of and repair the loading dock and dock steps;
1.9	(2) \$170,000 is to complete design of and repair roadway and to replace the campus'
1.10	main sign;
1.11	(3) \$100,000 is to complete design of and install storm drainage on the northwest
1.12	corner of campus; and
1.13	(4) \$1,100,000 is to design, construct, and equip technology infrastructure for
1.14	statewide outreach and online education and for campus safety and security.
1.15	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
1.16	bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
