1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to human services; modifying child care assistance provider rate differential  
1.3 for Parent Aware; amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 119B.13, subdivision  
1.4 3b.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 119B.13, subdivision 3b, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 3b. **Provider rate differential for Parent Aware.** A family child care provider  
1.8 or child care center shall be paid a five percent differential if the provider holds a one-star  
1.9 Parent Aware rating, a ten percent differential if the provider holds a two-star Parent Aware  
1.10 rating, a 15 percent differential if ~~they hold~~ the provider holds a three-star Parent Aware  
1.11 rating ~~or,~~ and a 20 percent differential if ~~they hold~~ the provider holds a four-star Parent  
1.12 Aware rating. A ~~15 percent or 20 percent~~ rate differential under this subdivision must be  
1.13 paid above the maximum rate established in subdivision 1, up to the actual provider rate.
