1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. APPROPRIATION; PILLSBURY UNITED COMMUNITIES.
1.6	(a) \$9,300,000 in fiscal year 2024 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.7	commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Pillsbury United
1.8	Communities, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, for capital improvements as provided in
1.9	this section.
1.10	(b) \$2,300,000 of this appropriation is to finalize design and site preparation for the
1.11	expanded workforce development creative arts campus that supports unhoused youth and
1.12	community members who are Black, Indigenous, and people of color to gain skills related
1.13	to bike mechanics, theater technology, technical arts design, and radio media.
1.14	(c) \$7,000,000 of this appropriation is to support construction of the expansion for
1.15	Pillsbury House Theatre and Full Cycle to construct interactive and accessible space to be
1.16	made available to and utilized by visitors, partner organizations, artists, and the greater
1.17	community to exchange ideas and build relationships.
1.18	(d) This is a onetime appropriation and is available until the project is completed or
1.19	abandoned, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642.
1.20	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective the day following final enactment.
