The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Environment, Energy and Natural Resources Policy and Finance

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to state lands; authorizing private sale of certain tax-forfeited land.  
1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **PRIVATE SALE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND; LAKE COUNTY.**

1.5 (a) Notwithstanding the public sale provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282,  
1.6 or other law to the contrary, Lake County may sell by private sale the tax-forfeited land  
1.7 described in paragraph (c).

1.8 (b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The attorney  
1.9 general may make changes to the land description to correct errors and ensure accuracy.

1.10 (c) The land to be sold is located in Lake County and is described as: the Northeast  
1.11 Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, Section 19, Township 56 North, Range 9 West.

1.12 (d) The county has determined that the county's land management interests would  
1.13 best be served if the lands were returned to private ownership.
