1.2 relating to human services; requiring exception to size limitation for customized

1.3 living and 24-hour customized living services for certain settings.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **DIRECTION TO COMMISSIONER; BRAIN INJURY AND**

1.6 **COMMUNITY ACCESS FOR DISABILITY INCLUSION WAIVER CUSTOMIZED**

1.7 **LIVING SERVICES PROVIDERS LOCATED IN HENNEPIN AND ITASCA**

1.8 **COUNTIES.**

1.9 The commissioner of human services shall determine the brain injury (BI) or community

1.10 access for disability inclusion (CADI) waiver customized living and 24-hour customized

1.11 living size limitation exception applies to:

1.12 (1) two United States Department of Housing and Urban Development-subsidized

1.13 housing settings created on September 29, 1980, that are located in the city of Minneapolis,

1.14 provide customized living and 24-hour customized living services for clients enrolled in

1.15 the BI and CADI waiver, and had a capacity to service six clients in the setting as of July

1.16 1, 2022; and

1.17 (2) one United States Department of Housing and Urban Development-subsidized housing

1.18 setting created on April 15, 1991, that is located in the city of Grand Rapids, provides

1.19 customized living and 24-hour customized living services for clients enrolled in the BI and

1.20 CADI waiver, and had a capacity to service eight clients in the setting as of July 1, 2022.
