The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Health and Human Services Reform

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a new Department of
1.3 Human Services Child and Adolescent Behavioral Health Services facility;
1.4 authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.
1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **CHILD AND ADOLESCENT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES**
1.7 **(CABHS).**

1.8 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$7,530,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9 fund to the commissioner of administration to purchase land in or near the city of Willmar
1.10 for, and to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip, a 16-bed psychiatric hospital
1.11 facility of approximately 17,500 to 18,000 square feet that will house the Child and
1.12 Adolescent Behavioral Health Services (CABHS) program. The facility shall include
1.13 space for single bedrooms, bathing and toilets, dining, living, group and treatment rooms,
1.14 education space, visitation, clinic/professional staff, operations staff, patient storage,
1.15 operations storage, food preparation, HVAC/telecommunications/data equipment, a small
1.16 area for indoor recreation, and a secure outdoor activity space. The property for the
1.17 facility will provide for staff and visitor parking, outdoor activities, and appropriate side,
1.18 front, and rear setbacks.

1.19 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
1.20 bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
1.21 bonds of the state in an amount up to \$7,530,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with
1.22 the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
1.23 Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

2.1 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
