By July 1, 2012, the commissioner of 1.6 transportation, after consultation with the commissioner of administration, shall approve, 1.7 select, and award a consultant contract to provide an analysis of the cost of pupil 1.8 transportation in this state and to recommend actions, best practices, and legislation to 1.9 achieve efficiencies and cost reductions in arranging for safe, efficient, and cost-effective 1 10 pupil transportation. 1 11 Subd. 2. Analysis. The consultant shall separately analyze pupil transportation in a 1.12 1.13 selected urban, suburban, and rural cluster of schools and districts. The consultant shall utilize the findings to project statewide costs and savings associated with recommendations 1.14 developed by the consultant.
