1.8	as an exclusive liquor store doing business as Broadway Liquor Outlet at 2201 West
1.9	Broadway, where the building housing the business at its current location was damaged
1.10	beyond reasonable repair by the 2011 tornado, to permit the ongoing interim operation of
1.11	the business in a temporary structure at the current location prior to the relocation of the
1.12	business to a permanent facility located across the street at 2200-2220 West Broadway, or
1.13	as this property is or may be more fully described in the property records of Hennepin
1.14	County, notwithstanding limitations of law, local ordinances, or charter provisions relating
1.15	to zoning or liquor licensing.
