The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Capital Investment

- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for an expansion of existing
- 1.3 solid waste and recyclable material facilities and processing equipment, and organic
- 1.4 compost site in Polk County; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. **POLK COUNTY; REGIONAL WASTE, RECYCLING, AND COMPOST**
- 1.7 **PROJECT - PHASE III.**
- 1.8 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$2,400,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.9 to the Pollution Control Agency for a solid waste capital assistance grant under Minnesota
- 1.10 Statutes, section 115A.54, to Polk County to design and construct an addition and
- 1.11 improvements to an existing waste processing and material recovery facility and organic
- 1.12 solid waste compost facility. This appropriation includes 50 percent of the cost of the material
- 1.13 recovery facility expansion and improvement and 50 percent of the cost of the organic solid
- 1.14 waste compost facility. This appropriation is not available until the commissioner of
- 1.15 management and budget determines that an amount sufficient to complete the project is
- 1.16 committed from nonstate sources. An additional renewable energy component shall not be
- 1.17 mandated as a requirement of this project to qualify for funding under this section.
- 1.18 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.19 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.20 the state in an amount up to \$2,400,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.21 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 1.22 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 1.23 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
