- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to campaign finance; decreasing threshold for registration; amending
- 1.3 Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 10A.14, subdivision 1.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 10A.14, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
- 1.6 Subdivision 1. **First registration.** (a) The treasurer of a political committee, political
- 1.7 fund, principal campaign committee, or party unit must register with the board by filing a
- 1.8 registration statement. The registration statement must be filed by the earliest of the following
- 1.9 dates:
- 1.10 (1) no later than 14 days after the committee, fund, or party unit has made a contribution,
- 1.11 received contributions, or made expenditures in excess of ~~\$750~~ \$200;
- 1.12 (2) no later than the next report of receipts and expenditures filing date applicable to the
- 1.13 committee, fund, or party unit if the committee, fund, or party unit reached the threshold in
- 1.14 clause (1) before the end of the reporting period covered by that report; or
- 1.15 (3) by the end of the next business day after it has received a loan or contribution that
- 1.16 must be reported under section 10A.20, subdivision 5.
- 1.17 (b) This subdivision does not apply to ballot question or independent expenditure political
- 1.18 committees or funds, which are subject to subdivision 1a.
