1.8	Subdivision 1. Sales restriction. Except as otherwise provided in subdivision 2,
1.9	no person shall sell or offer for sale to consumers in Minnesota on either the wholesale
1.10	or retail level, any personal care products, cosmetics, or cleaning products containing
1.11	triclosan unless the notice required by subdivision 3 is included in its labeling in a
1.12	conspicuous manner.
1.13	Subd. 2. Exception. Subdivision 1 does not apply to a product containing triclosan
