The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Jobs and Economic Development Finance and Policy

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a park and campground;
1.3 authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **BONNIE BELLE PARK; IRONTON.**

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$450,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7 fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the
1.8 city of Ironton to design, construct, and equip a park and campground and related facilities
1.9 on the former site of the Bonnie Belle Mine.

1.10 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
1.11 bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
1.12 bonds of the state in an amount up to \$450,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with
1.13 the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
1.14 Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
