1.14	(4) laboratory services;
1.15	(5) maternity and newborn care;
1.16	(6) mental health and substance use disorder services, including behavioral health
1.17	treatment;
1.18	(7) pediatric services, including oral and vision care;
1.19	(8) prescription drugs;
1.20	(9) preventive and wellness services and chronic disease management;
1.21	(10) rehabilitative and habilitative services and devices, including services for
1.22	autism spectrum disorder treatment specified pursuant to section 62A.3094; and
1.23	(11) additional essential health benefits included in the EHB-benchmark plan, as
