1.9	Subdivision 1. Service credit purchase authorized. (a) If paragraph (b) does not
1.10	apply, a teacher who has at least three years of allowable service credit with the Teachers
1.11	Retirement Association and who performed service in the United States armed forces
1.12	before becoming a teacher as defined in section 354.05, subdivision 2, or who failed
1.13	to obtain service credit for a military leave of absence under the provisions of section
1.14	354.53, is entitled to purchase allowable and formula service credit for the initial period of

The application must include all necessary documentation of the teacher's qualifications to make the purchase, signed written permission to allow the executive director to request and receive necessary verification of applicable facts and eligibility requirements, and any other relevant information that the executive director may require.

Subd. 3. **Service credit grant.** Allowable and formula service credit for the purchase period must be granted by the Teachers Retirement Association to the purchasing teacher upon receipt of the purchase payment amount. Payment must be made before the teacher's termination of teaching service the executive director's verification of the teacher's eligibility.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment. If a teacher has purchased military service credit from the Teachers Retirement Association before the effective date of this section under circumstances in which the person would be entitled to obtain the service credit without payment after that date, the Teachers Retirement Association must refund the purchase amount to the person.
