1.6	Section 1. INTEGRATED SPECIAL EDUCATION INFORMATION SYSTEM
1.7	PILOT GRANT.
1.8	Subdivision 1. Pilot project purpose. The purpose of the integrated special education
1.9	information system pilot project is to develop and implement a more efficient special
1.10	education information system that provides accurate and measurable data to achieve better
1.11	results for students and school staff.
1.12	Subd. 2. System components. The integrated special education information system
1.13	developed under this section must contain all of the individualized education program
1.14	information for each student, integrate third-party billing information, reduce staff time
1.15	necessary to prepare and input data, eliminate duplicate entries of the same information,
1.16	improve the availability of special education information, increase the reliability of special
1.17	education data, and automate reporting for students, school staff, and the state.
1.18	Subd. 3. Replicability. The system designed under this section must be replicable by
1.19	other school districts and charter schools. By January 15, 2023, Independent School District
1.20	No. 271, Bloomington, must make the design of the special education information system
1.21	developed under this section available to the commissioner of education and, as requested,
1.22	to other school districts and charter schools interested in pursuing a similar system.
