1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to education; appropriating money for a Girls in Action grant.
1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; GIRLS IN ACTION GRANT.**

1.5 \$1,625,000 in fiscal year 2017 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.6 commissioner of education for a grant to the Girls in Action program to enable Girls
1.7 in Action to continue to provide and to expand Twin Cities metropolitan area school
1.8 and community-based programs that encourage and support low-income girls, including
1.9 low-income girls of color, to graduate from high school on time, complete a postsecondary
1.10 preparation program, become community leaders, and participate in service learning
1.11 opportunities in their communities. Girls in Action must expend \$500,000 of this
1.12 appropriation for community-based programs located in the Twin Cities metropolitan
1.13 area. This appropriation remains available until expended.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for fiscal year 2017.
