.7	Subd. 6. <b>Home visiting levy revenue.</b> A district that is eligible to levy for early
.8	childhood family education under subdivision 3 and that enters into a collaborative
.9	agreement to provide education services and social services to families with young
.10	children may is eligible for home visiting revenue consisting of its home visiting aid and
.11	its home visiting levy. A district's home visiting aid equals \$1.32 times the number of
.12	people under five years of age residing in the district on September 1 of the last school
.13	year. A district's home visiting levy an amount equal to \$1.60 equals \$1.32 times the
.14	number of people under five years of age residing in the district on September 1 of the las
.15	school year. Levy revenue under this subdivision must not be included as revenue under
