1.8	vehicle while is prohibited from using a wireless communications device to compose, read,
1.9	or send an electronic message, when the vehicle is in motion or a part of traffic.
1.10	(b) A person who violates paragraph (a) is subject to the following fines:
1.11	(1) for a first offense, a fine of \$175, plus the amount specified in the uniform fine
