1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 187.03, is amended by adding a
1.8 subdivision to read:

1.9 Subd. 7a. Home and community-based services employee. "Home and
1.10 community-based services employee" means an individual employed by the individual's
1.11 child or spouse to provide:

1.12 (1) consumer-directed community supports services under chapter 256S and sections
1.13 256B.092 and 256B.49 or under the alternative care program authorized under section
1.14 256B.0913; or

1.15 (2) services under the community first services and supports program authorized under
1.16 section 256B.85 and Minnesota's federally approved waiver programs.

1.17 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.20 Subd. 7. Individuals not employed by a covered employer. (a) In addition to home
1.21 and community-based services employees under paragraph (b), the board may allow

2.1 the program, in which case the individual ~~shall~~ must be considered a covered employee for
2.2 purposes of sections 187.05 to 187.11.

2.3 (b) The board must allow any home and community-based services employee to open
2.4 and contribute to an account in the program within six months of the opening of the program
2.5 and must consider a home and community-based services employee a covered employee
2.6 for purposes of sections 187.05 to 187.11.
