1.6	Section 1. ST. PAUL; COMO ZOO.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$25,659,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8	fund to the Metropolitan Council for a grant to the city of St. Paul to design, construct,
1.9	furnish, and equip new habitats for lions, tigers, cougars, snow leopards, and wolves at the
1.10	Como Zoo in the city of St. Paul. In addition to exhibit space, the habitats will include space
1.11	for training, enrichment, off-exhibit animal housing, and veterinary care.
1.12	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.13	proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.14	the state in an amount up to \$25,659,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.15	prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.16	Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
