1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to motor vehicles; requiring a report examining a transition to digital driver
1.3 and vehicle documents.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. REPORT; TRANSITION TO DIGITAL TITLES AND DRIVERS'
1.6 LICENSES.

1.7 By December 15, 2022, the commissioner of public safety must report to the chairs and
1.8 ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over transportation
1.9 policy and finance on transitioning from physical driver and vehicle documents to digital
1.10 versions of the same documents. At a minimum, the report must:

1.11 (1) include information on how other states have implemented the transition to digital
1.12 documents;

1.13 (2) make recommendations on how to ensure the security, integrity, and privacy of data;

1.14 (3) include an estimate of the costs for transitioning to digital documents;

1.15 (4) include an estimated timeline for transitioning to digital documents; and

1.16 (5) identify statutory changes necessary to implement the transition to digital documents.

1.17 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective August 1, 2022.
