1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 297A.70, subdivision 20, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 20. Ice arenas and rinks. Sales to organizations that exist primarily for the purpose
1.8	of <u>owning or operating</u> ice arenas or rinks that are (1) part of <u>either</u> the Duluth Heritage
1.9	Sports Center or the David M. Thaler Sports Center; and (2) are used for youth and high
1.10	school programs, are exempt if the organization is a private, nonprofit corporation exempt
1.11	from federal income taxation under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
1.12	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for sales and purchases made after June
1.13	30, 2019.
