1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Laws 2023, chapter 64, article 4, section 27, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.8 to read:

1.9 Subd. 9. Report. (a) By January 15, 2025, a county, Tribal government, or local unit
1.10 that receives aid under this section must report the following information to the commissioner
1.11 of public safety in the form and manner prescribed by the commissioner of public safety:

1.12 (1) the amount of aid received; and

1.13 (2) the ways in which the aid was used or is intended to be used.

1.14 (b) By February 15, 2025, the commissioner of public safety must compile the information
1.15 received from counties, Tribal governments, or local units pursuant to paragraph (a) and
1.16 submit the compiled data to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over public safety
1.17 finance and policy.

1.18 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
