1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to transportation; requiring rumble strips at certain locations on the trunk
1.3 highway system; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter
1.4 161.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [161.1258] RUMBLE STRIPS.

1.7 (a) The commissioner must maintain transverse rumble strips in association with each
1.8 stop sign that is located (1) on a trunk highway segment with a speed limit of at least 55
1.9 miles per hour, and (2) outside the limits of a statutory or home rule charter city.

1.10 (b) The commissioner must meet the requirements under paragraph (a) at each applicable
1.11 location by the earlier of August 1, 2034, or the date of substantial completion of any
1.12 construction, resurfacing, or reconditioning at the location.
