Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 383B.908, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

Subd. 5. **Financial oversight.** The county board shall approve, by majority vote, the annual budget of the corporation and receive an annual audited financial statement. The annual budget shall address how efficiencies and revenues contribute to stabilize or reduce county liabilities for indigent care. The county board shall also retain the right to conduct an independent audit of the finances of the corporation.
