1.9	Subd. 2. Student connections aid. (a) For onetime aid to help connect students to their
1.10	schools and improve student attendance:
1.11	<u>\$ 20,000,000 2025</u>
1.12	(b) Each school district and charter school is eligible for onetime student connections
1.13	aid equal to \$20 times the district's fall 2023 total student enrollment. Each cooperative unit
1.14	identified in Minnesota Statutes, section 123A.24, subdivision 2, is eligible for onetime
1.15	student connections aid equal to \$2 times the student enrollment of its member districts. If
1.16	a district is a member of more than one cooperative unit that serves students, the revenue
1.17	must be allocated among the cooperative units.
1.18	(c) Student connections aid must be used for programs that build connections to students
1.19	and encourage regular school attendance. A school may provide a program with its own
