- 1.6Section 1. [62Q.5291] DISPENSING FEE.
- 1.7Subdivision 1. Minimum dispensing fee. A health plan that provides prescription
- 1.8coverage must pay, for the pharmacy service in dispensing a prescribed drug, a dispensing
- 1.9fee in an amount at least equal to the dispensing fee in section 256B.0625, subdivision 13e,
- 1.10paragraph (a).
- 1.11Subd. 2. Medical assistance and MinnesotaCare excluded. This section does not apply
- 1.12to managed care plans or county-based purchasing plans when the plan provides coverage
- 1.13to public health care program enrollees under chapter 256B or 256L.
