The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Public Safety Finance and Policy

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to the legislature; requiring members of public safety policy and finance
1.3 committees to participate in ride alongs with law enforcement or fire departments;
1.4 requiring adoption of legislative rules; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.5 Statutes, chapter 3.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. 3.057 PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEMBERS.

1.8 (a) A member of the legislature who serves on a legislative committee with jurisdiction
1.9 over public safety policy or finance must participate in a ride along with law enforcement
1.10 or a fire department for at least 12 hours each biennium.

1.11 (b) The house of representatives and the senate must adopt rules to implement this
1.12 section.
