ARROWHEAD REGIONAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER. 1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$8,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund 1.7 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of 1.8 Hermantown to prepare the middle school site on the Hermantown School District campus, 1.9 including demolition of a portion of the middle school, and to design, construct a new 1.10 addition to the middle school building and renovate the remaining existing building, furnish, 1.11 and equip the facility as the Arrowhead Regional Health and Wellness Center.
