1.7	Section 1. APPROPRIATION.
1.8	\$500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the Metropolitan Council
1.9	for a grant to Coon Rapids to predesign, design, and construct a bicycle and pedestrian
1.10	trail along 85th Avenue westbound from the BNSF Railroad tracks to East River Road and
1.11	through adjacent park land to connect with the regional trail in the city of Coon Rapids.
1.12	Sec. 2. BOND SALE.
1.13	To provide the money appropriated in section 1 from the bond proceeds fund, the
1.14	commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an
1.15	amount up to \$500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by
1.16	Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution,
1.17	article XI, sections 4 to 7.
