1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; BIG BROTHERS BIG SISTERS.**

1.6 \$500,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 2021 are appropriated from the

1.7 workforce development fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development

1.8 for a grant to Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Greater Twin Cities for workforce readiness,

1.9 employment exploration, and skills development for youth ages 12 to 21. The grant must

1.10 serve youth in the Big Brothers Big Sisters chapters in the Twin Cities, central Minnesota,

1.11 and southern Minnesota.
