2.1 The exemption provided under this paragraph does not apply to a U. S. armed forces
2.2 reserve technician.

2.3 (c) Any person while driving or operating any farm tractor or implement of
2.4 husbandry temporarily on a highway is exempt. For purposes of this section, an all-terrain
2.5 vehicle, as defined in section 84.92, subdivision 8, an off-highway motorcycle, as defined
2.6 in section 84.787, subdivision 7, and an off-road vehicle, as defined in section 84.797,
2.7 subdivision 7, are not implements of husbandry.

2.8 (d) A nonresident who is at least 15 years of age and who has in immediate
2.9 possession a valid driver's license issued to the nonresident in the home state or country
2.10 may operate a motor vehicle in this state only as a driver.

2.11 (e) A nonresident who has in immediate possession a valid commercial driver's
2.12 license issued by a state or jurisdiction in accordance with the standards of Code of
2.13 Federal Regulations, title 49, part 383, and who is operating in Minnesota the class of
2.14 commercial motor vehicle authorized by the issuing state or jurisdiction is exempt.

2.15 (f) Any nonresident who is at least 18 years of age, whose home state or country does
2.16 not require the licensing of drivers may operate a motor vehicle as a driver, but only for a
2.17 period of not more than 90 days in any calendar year, if the motor vehicle so operated is
2.18 duly registered for the current calendar year in the home state or country of the nonresident.

2.19 (g) Any person who becomes a resident of the state of Minnesota and who has in
2.20 possession a valid driver's license issued to the person under and pursuant to the laws of
2.21 some other state or jurisdiction or by military authorities of the United States may operate
2.22 a motor vehicle as a driver, but only for a period of not more than 60 days after becoming
2.23 a resident of this state, without being required to have a Minnesota driver's license as
2.24 provided in this chapter.

2.25 (h) Any person who becomes a resident of the state of Minnesota and who has in
2.26 possession a valid commercial driver's license issued by another state or jurisdiction in
2.27 accordance with the standards of Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, part 383, is exempt
2.28 for not more than 30 days after becoming a resident of this state.

2.29 (i) Any person operating a snowmobile, as defined in section 84.81, is exempt.

2.30 (j) Any person who is a locomotive engineer, assistant engineer, conductor, or
2.31 other member of the crew of a railroad locomotive or train or an operator of on-track
2.32 equipment being operated upon rails, including operation while crossing a public or
2.33 private street, road, or highway. A person employed as described in this paragraph is
2.34 not required to display or furnish a motor vehicle driver's license to a law enforcement
2.35 officer in connection with the operation of a railroad locomotive or train or on-track
2.36 equipment within Minnesota. No citation involving the operation of a locomotive, train,

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- 3.1 or on-track equipment in violation of this chapter or chapter 169 may be issued against
3.2 the locomotive engineer or any crew member of the railroad locomotive or train or an
3.3 operator of on-track equipment.
