A bill for an act

relating to civil law; extending civil immunity to municipalities that donate fire and rescue equipment; amending Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 466.03, by adding a subdivision.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 466.03, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 23. **Donated fire and rescue equipment.** (a) A tort claim resulting from the use of fire and rescue equipment donated by a municipality to another municipality, unless the claim is a direct result of fraud or intentional misrepresentation.

(b) As used in this subdivision, "fire and rescue equipment" means equipment purchased or obtained through gifts or grants by a municipality for use by the municipality's fire department to engage in or train for fire or rescue operations.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2011, and applies to actions arising from incidents occurring on or after that date.
