1.5	Section 1. MINNESOTA STATE ACADEMIES.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. (a) \$6,700,000 is appropriated from the bond
1.7	proceeds fund to the commissioner of administration for capital improvements at the
1.8	Minnesota State Academies.
1.9	(b) \$6,200,000 of this appropriation is to design, construct, furnish, and equip a new
1.10	technology center on the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf campus. This technology
1.11	center of approximately 20,336 square feet, an addition to Smith Hall on the Minnesota
1.12	State Academy for the Deaf campus, will serve students from both the Minnesota State
