1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. AMERICAN INDIAN LEARNING RESOURCE CENTER;

1.7UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA, DULUTH.

1.8Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$7,350,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

1.9fund to the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to design, construct, furnish,

1.10and equip an American Indian Learning Resource Center on the Duluth campus to

1.11colocate existing programs and with space for academic and service programs, classrooms,

1.12a computer lab, conference rooms, office space, and a great room for gatherings.

1.13Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the

1.14bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue

1.15bonds of the state in an amount up to \$7,350,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with

1.16the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the

1.17Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.18**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
