1.4	Section 1. FIRE SAFETY ACCOUNT; APPROPRIATIONS.
1.5	\$12,960,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$12,960,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated
1.6	from the fire safety account in the special revenue fund to the commissioner of public safety
1.7	for activities under Minnesota Statutes, section 299F.012. Of this amount:
1.8	(1) \$4,263,000 each year is to fund the Minnesota Board of Firefighter Training and
1.9	Education for activities recommended by the fire safety advisory committee under Minnesota
1.10	Statutes, section 299F.012, subdivision 2;
