1.5	Section 1. HOUSING FINANCE AGENCY; APPROPRIATION.
1.6	(a) \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2016 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.7	commissioner of housing finance for a competitive grants program to fund housing
1.8	projects with training centers for jobs in high-growth job areas.
1.9	(b) Grants must be no more than 50 percent of the total development costs for the
1.10	project and shall be awarded to housing projects in communities:
1.11	(1) that have low housing vacancy rates; and
1.12	(2) that have an education and training center for jobs in agriculture, farm business
1.13	management, health care fields, or other fields with anticipated significant job growth
1.14	potential.
1.15	(c) Funds for grants made in this section must be to housing projects that have
1.16	financial and in-kind contributions from nonagency sources that when combined with a
