- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to motor vehicles; amending the distribution of contributions made for
- 1.3 Law Enforcement Memorial Association license plates; requiring a report;
- 1.4 amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 168.1294, subdivision 6.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 168.1294, subdivision 6, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subd. 6. **Contributions; memorial account; appropriation.** Contributions collected
- 1.8 under subdivision 1, clause (4), must be deposited in the Minnesota law enforcement
- 1.9 memorial account, which is established in the special revenue fund. Money in the account
- 1.10 is appropriated to the commissioner of public safety. This appropriation is first for the annual
- 1.11 cost of administering the account funds, and the remaining funds are for distribution to the
- 1.12 Minnesota Law Enforcement Memorial Association, ~~to be used.~~ By July 15 of each year,
- 1.13 the commissioner must distribute all funds remaining to the association. The association
- 1.14 must use the funds to further the mission of the association in assisting the families and
- 1.15 home agencies of Minnesota law enforcement officers who have died in the line of duty.
- 1.16 By August 15 of each year, the association must report to the commissioner of public safety
- 1.17 and to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction
- 1.18 over transportation policy and finance. The report must include an itemized list of each
- 1.19 expenditure the association made with the funds received under this section.
- 1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2019.
