.6	Subd. 1a. Officers and employees. The liability of an officer or an employee
.7	of any municipality for a tort arising out of an alleged act or omission occurring in the
.8	performance of duty shall not exceed the limits set forth in subdivision 1, unless the
.9	officer or employee provides professional services and <del>also is employed in the profession</del>
.10	for compensation by a person or persons other than the municipality, at the time of the
.11	alleged act or omission, was acting in a professional capacity, for compensation, outside of
.12	the officer's or employee's municipal employment or position.
.13	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective August 1, 2012, and applies to
.14	actions arising from incidents occurring on or after that date.
