Section 1. APPROPRIATION; METROPOLITAN CENTER FOR INDEPENDENT 1.5 LIVING. 1.6

A bill for an act

\$7,500,000 is appropriated from the general fund in fiscal year 2022 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the Metropolitan Center for Independent Living to acquire land for and to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip the renovation and expansion of the existing Metropolitan Center for Independent Living facility on Robert Street in St. Paul. The renovated and expanded facility will provide a broad range of independent living, vocational, case management, and other important services for persons with disabilities in the seven-county metropolitan area. This appropriation is available until the project is completed or abandoned, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642.
