BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. MINNESOTA SEX OFFENDER PROGRAM, ST. PETER.

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$14,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of administration to complete design, construct, renovate, furnish, and equip the second phase of a multiphase project to develop additional residential, program, activity, and ancillary facilities for the Minnesota sex offender program on the lower campus of the St. Peter Regional Treatment Center. This appropriation includes funds to complete design, renovate, construct, furnish, and equip the north wing of Green Acres; to complete design, renovate, construct, furnish, and equip the west, south, and north wings of Sunrise; and to complete design, renovate, construct, furnish, and equip the Tomlinson building. The appropriation includes funds to: replace or renovate the three buildings, HVAC, plumbing, electrical, security, and life safety systems; replace, reconfigure, and remodel space; design and abate asbestos and other hazardous materials; remove or demolish nonfunctioning building components; and complete site work necessary to support the programmed use of these buildings.

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$14,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with
