1.10	(a) \$120,000 in fiscal year 2017 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.11	commissioner of education for a grant to Independent School District No. 625, St. Paul,
1.12	for an after-school, culturally focused arts program to improve the reading, math, and life
1.13	skills of 75 to 100 underperforming students in kindergarten through grade 5 by engaging
1.14	and immersing them in their art, history, and culture and providing them with math, literacy,
1.15	and life skills coaching, all in an effort to reduce the district's academic achievement gap.
