Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 444.075, is amended by adding a subdivision
to read:
Subd. 7. Ordinances; responsibility for maintenance of water service pipes. A
municipality must not enact, amend, or enforce an ordinance that establishes private
ownership and responsibility for maintenance of water service pipes from the point of
connection at a building receiving water service to the municipal water main. A local
ordinance may establish private ownership and responsibility for maintenance of water

service pipes from the point of connection at the building receiving water service to the

curb stop or property line. A local ordinance contrary to this subdivision is void.
