1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. **TESTING FOR AND REMEDIATION OF LEAD IN DRINKING WATER**
1.8 **AT CERTAIN FACILITIES; APPROPRIATION.**

1.9 \$..... in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of
1.10 health to conduct statewide testing for the presence of lead in drinking water obtained from
1.11 private wells, day care facilities, and rental properties and to remediate contamination where
1.12 found. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require the owner or lessee of a property
1.13 to submit to drinking water testing.

1.14 Sec. 2. **INFRASTRUCTURE TRANSPARENCY TOOL UPGRADES;**
