1.5	Section 1. UNREALIZED BUSINESS GRANT PROGRAM.
1.6	Subdivision 1. <b>Definitions.</b> (a) For the purposes of this section, the following terms have

1.8	(b) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of employment and economic development.
1.9	(c) "Eligible business" means a business that:
1.10	(1) completed a new business filing with the secretary of state in the 12 months preceding

1.12	Order No. 20-04 and subsequent state-mandated closures; and
