| BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: |
| Section 1. CITATION. |
| This act may be cited as the "Outdoor Place-Based Education Act." |
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| Sec. 2. <u>DEFINITIONS.</u> |
| For purposes of this act, "outdoor place-based education" means the process of |
| using the local community and outdoor environment as a starting point to teach concepts |
| in language arts, mathematics, social studies, science, history, and other subjects across |
| the curriculum. |

| Sec. 3. OUTDOOR PLACE-BASED EDUCATION ADVISORY GROUP. |
| Subdivision 1. Advisory group creation. The outdoor place-based education |
| advisory group consists of the following 13 members: |
| (1) commissioners of the following agencies or their designees: |

| (ii) the Department of Natural Resources; |
| (2) 11 public members who have demonstrated an interest in outdoor skills and |
| education: |
