1.8	Subd. 12. Sports official. (a) Whoever assaults a sports official while the official is		
1.9	engaged in the performance of the official's duties, and inflicts demonstrable bodily harm,		
1.10	is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.		
1.11	(b) As used in this subdivision, "sports official" means a person who serves as an umpire,		
1.12	referee, judge, linesperson, timer, scorekeeper, or in another similar capacity for a youth		
1.13	athletic activity as defined in section 121A.38, subdivision 1, paragraph (e).		
1.14	(c) A sports official is engaged in the performance of the official's duties when the person		
1.15	<u>is:</u>		
1.16	(1) serving in a capacity described in paragraph (b);		
1.17	(2) on the premises or in the parking lot where the youth athletic activity is taking place;		
1.18	or		
1.19	(3) traveling between the premises and a public transit stop or a motor vehicle.		
1.20	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective August 1, 2019, and applies to crimes		
1.21	committed on or after that date.
