1.2relating to capital improvements; appropriating money for renovation and expansion

1.3of the Minneapolis American Indian Center.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. APPROPRIATION.

1.6\$7,600,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of employment

1.7and economic development for a grant to the Minneapolis American Indian Center to design,

1.8renovate, and expand the center on Franklin Avenue. This project includes: demolition

1.9work; improvements and additions to, or replacement of, the mechanical, electrical, plumbing,

1.10heating, ventilating, and air conditioning systems; repairs to the existing roof and exterior

1.11enclosure; required site improvements; general renovation of interior spaces; expansion of

1.12the cafe space, the event spaces, and the performance spaces; and furnishing and equipping

1.13the center. This appropriation is available when the commissioner of management and

1.14budget determines that sufficient resources have been committed to complete the project,

1.15as required by Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.

1.16EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
